

Finally, drinking water at the Center

From its creation in 2004 to the present day, the Senufo Cultural Center in Sikasso has been faced with a crucial need for drinking water. This shortage was most felt during the dry season when welcoming the visitors to the center and the maintenance of its gardens became a heavier burden to carry.

Thanks to the support of Missio International Katholiches Missionswerk, this problem is now solved. We are deeply grateful. It is also an opportunity to thank all our Swiss friends, the Missionaries of Africa (White Fathers) and all those who from near or far contribute to the progress of the Senufo Cultural Center. To all our future users of this water, we appeal for a resolute ecological attitude in as far as respecting our mother - nature is concerned.

Entrusted to a native Sikasso company called Sika-Service-Express-Sarl, this project resulted in the completion of three boreholes - one in each of the three sites of the center, the installation of three electric pumps, two large tanks of 2000 ml each and a 5000ml water tower. The realization of this project comes to reinforce the capacities of the beneficiaries of the center activities and to awaken the ecological attitude in them. Finally, the abundance of water will certainly be an asset for the center's future projects.
