

Reading workshop

The beginning of a new calendar year often tends to slow down the pace of many activities. This is not the case for the Sénoufo Cultural Center. On the other hand, the year 2019 has just propelled the Center team and its collaborators to a higher speed in their commitment to the promotion and safeguarding of African cultural heritage.

For two hours, the Center puts at the disposal of the students educators who help them discover the art of the reading and at the same time incorporating useful elements of the culture. Other students are also introduced to plastic art. These courses are different from one-off (timely) events that are organized in close connection with academic institutions.
